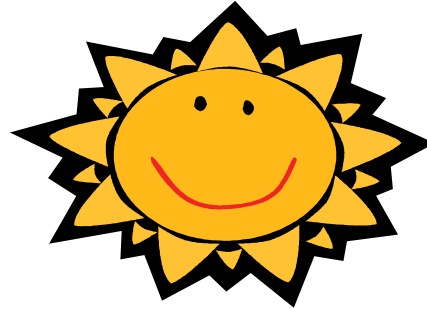


Will-O-Wisp Newsletter April 2010

MOUNTAIN PINE BEETLE SPRAYING

Out On A Limb Tree Service has been spraying in Will-O-Wisp every year since the current Mountain Pine Beetle cycle started in 1999. They have given us a reduced rate because of the number of WOW homeowners participating.

If you have pines, particularly ponderosa, lodgepole, scotch and timber pine, that are 8 inches or more in diameter, you probably will want to spray them each year until the current beetle infestation is over.

Pine Beetles are so small, about an eighth of an inch long. We cannot see them when they fly from trees they have killed, to healthy trees during August & September. Once a tree is infested, it is almost certain to die. If you would like to know more about Mountain Pine Beetles, and the benefits of spraying, CSU has a good web site:
