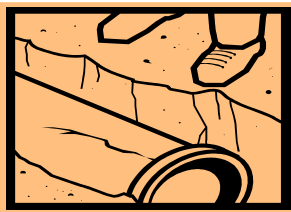


Important Notice Regarding WOW Roads...Please Read!!!



For over 8 years, WOW had been asking Park County to fix our roads! Last August, 2009, the WOW Road Committee went before the Park County Board of County Commissioners. Since it was late in the year Park County did what they could, and now here we are Spring 2010...and the work has begun!

There is always some inconvenience for the local traffic and routines to accomplish construction projects. There will be many delays during the construction phase. We will need the full cooperation of the residents of WOW to be able to perform these operations. There will be dust involved as sweeping the excess chip is also necessary before the final fog seal can be applied. Normally construction sites get worse before it gets better. **Beginning immediately we will try to notify WOW residents one to two days prior to scheduled construction with a large notice posted by the mail boxes.**



A large part of the deterioration of our roads has been caused by improper drainage. Without proper drainage, water run-off seeps under the roads lifting the asphalt...and especially so in the winter when water freezes. According to Park County Road & Bridge Land Use Regulations...culverts under private driveways are the responsibility of the homeowner, and culverts intersecting with County roads are the County's responsibility. **The driveway culverts need to be cleaned and reestablished by the property owners for the drainage to flow properly. This will be necessary before the job can move forward.**

Homeowners will be notified by Park County to fix their culvert or the work will be done for them with a charge!
